

Anatomy of a Smartpen

- Computer in a pen
- OLED Display
- Microphone
- Built-in Speaker
- Replaceable Ink/Stylus
- Infrared Camera
- Micro USB Connection
- Rechargeable Battery
- Connects to Computer
- Headset Jack
- Cap (Protect Ink and Camera)



8GB of memory 800 hours audio 128,000 pages of notes

Livescribe Headsets

Stereo Recording

- High fidelity recording system
- Moves microphone source away from surface of paper to reduce scratchy sound of pen on paper

Spatial Audio

- Binaural recording
- 3-dimensional sound
- Strong sense of presence
- Distinguish voices by location
- Tune out unwanted sounds


Record Notes and Audio – Step 1






Tap the record button to begin recording audio

Record Notes and Audio – Step 2




Write notes on paper as you normally would

Record Notes and Audio – Step 3





Tap the stop button to end recording audio



Paper Replay Controls



Pause – works during record and playback

Stop – ends a recording session or playback

Jump – 10 second increments, tap and hold for speed jump

Bookmarks – flag key points in audio file


Jump to position – quick way to get to beginning, middle, end

Playback speed – Minus (90, 80, 70, 60, 50), Plus (120, 140, 160, 180, 200)

Volume – increase and decrease volume of speakers or headsets

Mute – mutes the speaker not the microphone


Notebook Pages

- Feed through a printer


Printable Notepads

- Feed printed pages through printer












