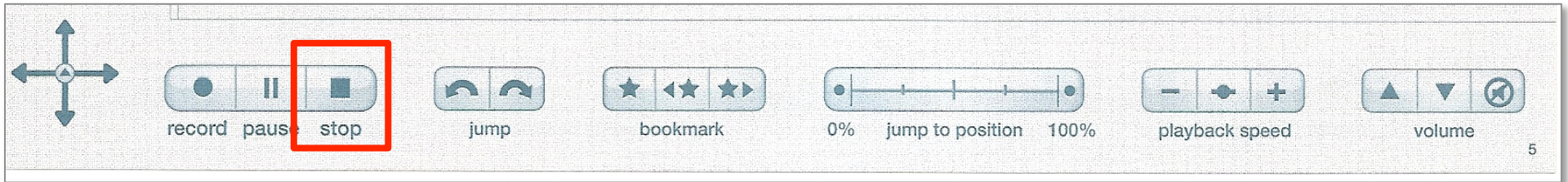

# Paper Replay Controls



**Pause** – works during record and playback

**Stop** – ends a recording session or playback

**Jump** – 10 second increments, tap and hold for speed jump

**Bookmarks** – flag key points in audio file

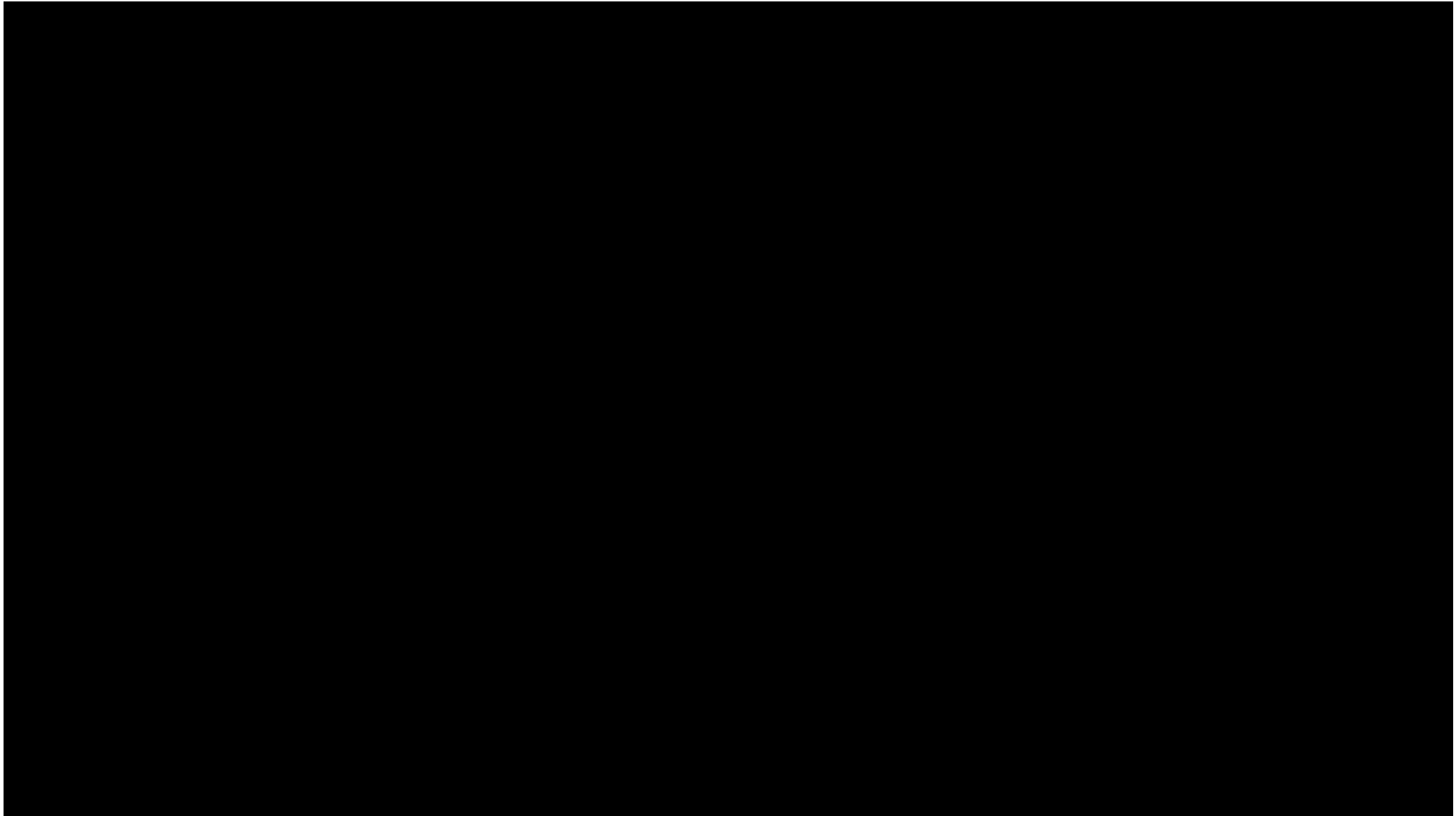
**Jump to position** – quick way to get to beginning, middle, end

**Playback speed** – Minus (90, 80, 70, 60, 50), Plus (120, 140, 160, 180, 200)

**Volume** – increase and decrease volume of speakers or headsets

**Mute** – mutes the speaker not the microphone

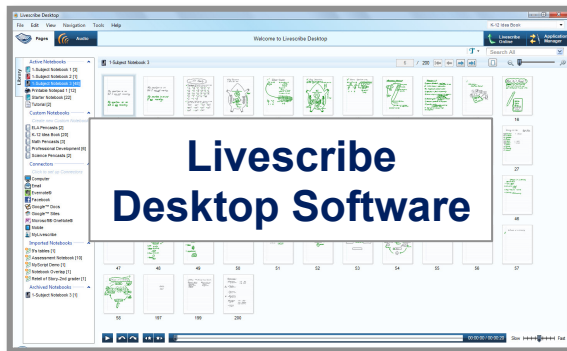

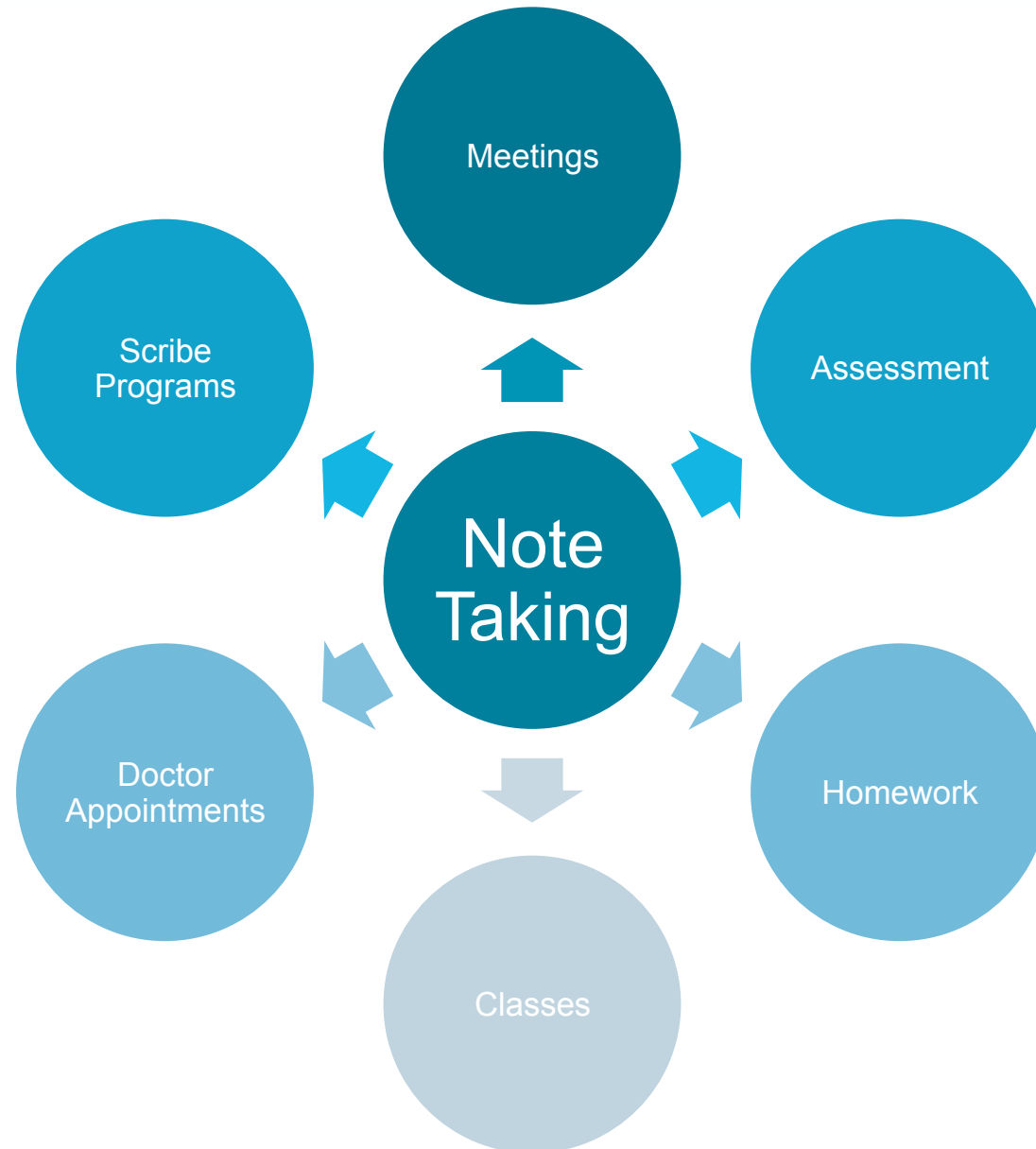

**Lesson 1 - Connect & Wonder**

**Objective:** Students will make connections from what they have learned from previously read novels written by female authors and develop questions they want to explore during this unit of study.

**Inquiry Stages:** Connect & Wonder

**Materials:**

- Printables by Betty Byars
- Jack Everlighting by Natalie Babbitt
- Number the Stars by Lois Lowry
- Connect and Wonder About Authors Worksheet

**Lesson:**

- Students will explore three books they have previously read to make connections about what they have in common. (Probably by Betty Byars, Jack Everlighting by Natalie Babbitt, and Number the Stars by Lois Lowry)
- Based on what they know about the life of Natalie Babbitt and why she chose to write fantasy books, have students predict what might have happened in the lives of Lois Lowry and Betty Byars that made them write their novels.
- Have students develop questions for further research about how personal experiences of a female author might influence her writing style.
- During each of these three areas hold a class discussion regarding students' answers and thoughts.

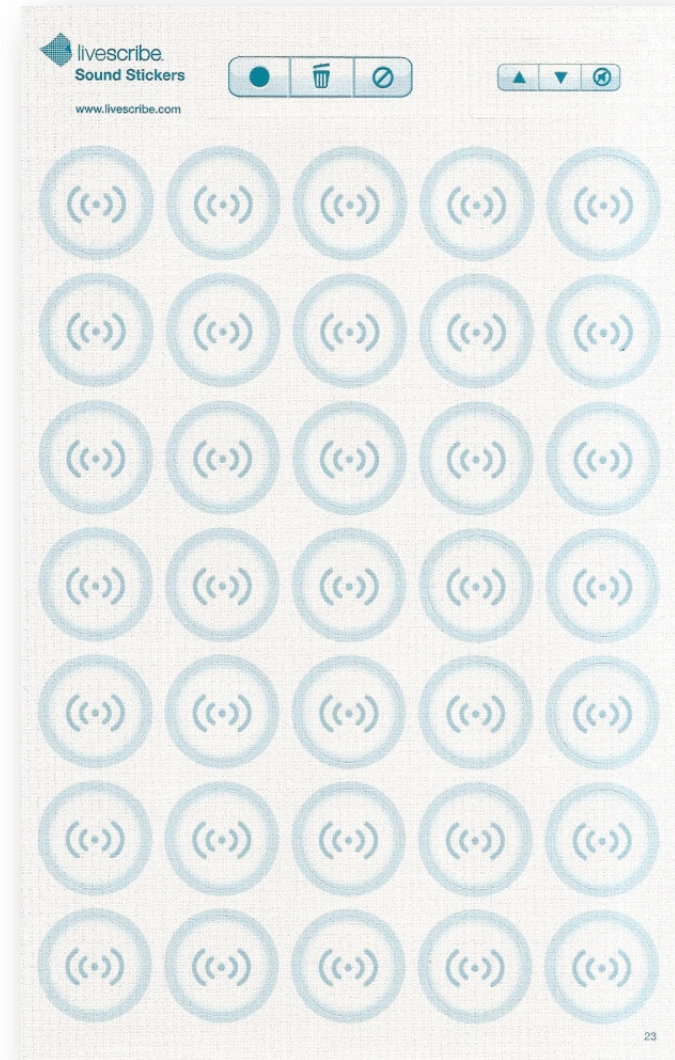
